



Loughborough Car Club Championships

Club Championships Rules

1. The Club championship year runs from 1st January to 31st December
2. All points must be claimed within 3 months of the event taking place, with the exception at the end of the championship year when the information must be lodged by 31st December.
3. Points may be lodged with the points secretary by any of the following means
 - a. Published in the club magazine
 - b. In writing, *using post, email or text* to the points secretary
4. It is the member's responsibility to ensure that the points secretary has clearly received the information.
5. To receive an award, a competitor must, *whenever possible*, display a sticker showing the Club's logo. Photographic evidence may be requested. This does not apply to marshals or navigators/co-drivers in non club members cars
6. To receive one of the club's major awards a competitor must also have marshalled on an event or made a major contribution to one of the Club's activities.
7. The committee shall be empowered to allocate or remove points should there be an ambiguity or an obvious injustice.
8. Points are allocated for the various championships as follows: -

On events with an entry of 30 or less, class and overall points will be halved. Any resulting fraction in the overall scores will be rounded up to the next whole number.

SPEED EVENTS, AUTOTEST, SOLO & TRIALS CHAMPIONSHIPS (excluding evening and half day events)

Points based on class position as follows:-

In addition 1 point will be scored for each starter beaten in the class up to a maximum of 3 points and one point deducted for each competitor beaten. There will be no negative points.

i.e. 1st in a class of six will receive 3 extra points (maximum 3 points) less 0 points as no-one was higher placed. Total additional points:- 3.

2nd in a class of six would receive 3 points less the one point for the 1 car ahead, Total additional points:- 2.

Second in a class of three, would receive 1 point less one point for the car ahead, Total additional points:- 0.

Production Car Autotest (PCA)

Stand alone PCAs and those run over the same course and at the same time as an autotest will score points in the autotest championship. Those run alongside autosolos will score points in the autosolo championship.

Trials include Production, Sporting and Classic Trials. On events where gold, silver and bronze medals (or the equivalent) are awarded rather than class finishing positions, points will be awarded as follows: -

Finishing the event 12 points, plus an additional

Gold – 13 points Silver – 8 points Bronze – 2 points

12 CAR SERIES – LoCC organised events only

Within the 12 car series there will be three classes based on the navigator's status:-

EXPERT: The committee will nominate individual navigators for expert status. To be considered for expert status a navigator must have 3 or more top 2 finishes. Expert navigators will be given expert handouts.

NOVICE: No longer a beginner and not yet nominated as an expert. Novice navigators will be given novice handouts or a help sheet

BEGINNER: The navigator has finished up to three events. Beginners will be given the novice handouts, plus any other assistance the organisers deem appropriate, 40 minutes before their start time.

For the purposes of calculating overall 12 car series positions, 12 car organisers will be allocated 12 points. Competitors will be awarded 12 points for finishing 1st overall down to 1 point for 12th overall and non-finishes. Points will also be accrued in the Clubman's championship as detailed above.

1st, 2nd and 3rd Overall trophies will be awarded in the 12 Car Series

EVENING AUTOTEST and/or AUTOSOLO SERIES LoCC organised events only

Points will be awarded on a class basis: 25 points for 1st in class down to 1 for 25th in class or a non-finish

If there are 5 or more events in the championship the lowest score will be dropped. Note, if you miss an event you score zero.

There will be at least 1 award per class. If 10 or more members did 2 or more events a second in class trophy will be awarded. If 20 or more members did 2 or more events a third in class trophy will be awarded.

MARSHALS CHAMPIONSHIP

A member is eligible to claim points for 'marshalling' on **any** motor sport event. In addition to this, the club will specify up to 7 events in each calendar year that will score bonus points. These will include the Club's major events along with selected other events that the club wants to endorse.

Points will be awarded to individuals as follows:

All the Club's major all day events. Additional events (such as stage rallies where the club has agreed to marshal a stage) Members will be notified about these events in the club magazine or by Email.

JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP

The Junior Championship is open to all members who are under 18 years old on 1st January of the championship year. Final championship positions will be based on the combined score from the Clubmans' and Marshals championships. Additional points may be allocated at the Committees discretion, should Junior member win one of the Club's major awards they will become ineligible for the Junior Championship.
