EVENING EVENTS FOR FUN

1. The Loughborough Car Club Ltd will organise seven evening Clubmen's Production Car Autotests.
2. On Tuesdays 6th & 20th June, 4th & 18th July and 1st, 15th & 29th August at Paddy's Lane MR 129/648225. What3words "freed.jazzy.owned"
3. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of Motorsports UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of FISA), these Regulations and any written instructions that the club may issue for the event.
4. Motorsport UK Permits will be issued.
5. The event is open to: - All fully elected members of the Loughborough Car Club, Mid-Derbyshire MC, Coalville Car Club, HRCR & Rugby MC and any other clubs invited in an amendment.
6. All competitors and passengers have the relevant club membership card and hold at least an RS Clubmen's Licence.
7. The programme of the meeting will be: - Signing-on 18.00 – 17.30, Tests open at 18.30 and close at 21.00.
8. Public roads will not be used as link sections. There will be at least 6 tests on private land.
9. Classes: -
The event will consist of three classes as follows: -
Class A Short wheelbase, up to and including 95in. (plus Series 1 Ford Ka)
Class B Long wheelbase, over 95 in.
Class C All cars with 4x4 and FWD with an LSD plus anything at the Clerk of the Course's discretion.
10. All vehicles must comply with Motorsport UK technical regulations.
IMPORTANT no "knobbles", Winter, Gravel or M&S tyres.
The intention is to exclude aggressive tyres which damage the field.
11. The event will be using a timing & results App called "TimingAppLive" Competitors will only need a smartphone with this App to view the results in real time.
12. There are no Event awards.
Note: Loughborough Car Club runs a Club Championship for full members based upon the seven events.
13. The entry list opens on publication.
Entry fee of £23.00 per event must be transferred to A/c No: 81466852 Sort Code: 40-43-39
Refunds will be in full for any entries withdrawn up to 19.00 on the day of the event. Withdrawal can be by email, text, WhatsApp. Should the event be cancelled, there will be full refunds.
14. Entries should be submitted on RallyAppLive.
15. The minimum age for a Driver or Passenger is 14. An adult with a full RTA licence must be in the car.

17. The maximum entry for the event is 40, the minimum is 10.
The minimum for each class is 3. Should any of the above minimum figures not be reached the organisers have the right to either cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary. Entries will be selected in order of receipt. If there are more than 40 entries reserves will be taken and places allocated in order of entry receipt.

19. Passengers must be carried.
20. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible following the end of the event.
21. Competitors must follow the "one-way system" & The tests must be attempted in order.
22. Marking and penalties will be as printed in the appropriate section of the Motorsport UK General Regulations.
23. Car sharing is permitted with a maximum of three drivers per car.
24. Drivers may only enter once.
