

THE 2023 CRACKERJACK RALLY

TUESDAY 7TH NOVEMBER 2023



We are getting the 2023/24 winter 12 Car season started with an enjoyable 60 mile navigation event run around some classic roads in Nottinghamshire and Leicestershire on Map 129 (latest edition).

Start from the **Greyhound Inn** at Burton on the Wolds, familiar by now to those who go for a drink or a meal after the grass autotests. MTC1 will be at 129/591½212 as you leave the pub car park to regain the public road. Navigation will be varied but straightforward, with a regularity section as a tie-decider. There are help sheets for non-experts and additional 60 minutes plotting time for beginners. Car '0' at MTC1 at 8 o'clock.

Control locations, passage controls and timing will all be provided by the Rally Live app. It is therefore essential that the navigator has the app loaded before the event and takes responsibility for having a fully-charged phone. Marshals will be out to observe give way junctions and perform 'envelope checks' at certain controls; this means that marshals will be present on the route but will not be expected to stick their heads through the window of your car. Passage checks will be recorded by crews.

The route uses 'coloured roads only' and has been traversed in a standard road car. However, the event should still be a challenge for both crew members.
