Event Supplementary Regulations

As in previous years we will be using the car park under the dual carriageway this means the usual big concrete pillars and hordes of spectators.

[1] Announcement

Loughborough Car Club Ltd will organise a Clubmans Autotest on 01 June 2025 at Grove Street Car Park, Coventry, CV1 5DL What 3 Words: origin.harder.shortcuts

[2] Jurisdiction

This meeting will be held under the National Competition Rules (NCR) of Motorsport UK (ASN) (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), and these Supplementary Regulations.

[3] Permits

[4] Eligibility

The Event is open to all fully elected members of Loughborough Car Club Ltd, BTRDA, and registered contenders in the championships listed below.

All competitors must hold at least at an RS Clubmans Licence and a valid club card

[5] CHAMPIONSHIPS The Event is a Round of:-

British Autotest Championship
BTRDA Demon Tweaks BestFed Autotest Championship
BTRDA Allrounders Championship

[6] EVENT PROGRAMME

Scrutineering Starts at - 8:30am

Event Start - 10:30am

Any competitor not signed on by 10:30 may be disqualified

[7] DESCRIPTION OF EVENT

There will be 3 tests and up to 6 runs per tests. All runs will count towards the overall total.

Details of the tests will be distributed with the final instructions.

[8] Classes

- (A) Saloon Cars under 11ft overall length (inc. Minis with non-original engine and transmission layout driving the front wheels);
- (B) All other Saloon Cars;
- (C) Sports Cars & Sports Kit Cars;
- (D) Specials;
- (E) Roadgoing Series Production Cars and Roadgoing Kit Cars;

Cabriolets must run in the appropriate saloon car class with roof/hood up, or class C or E with the roof/hood down, as appropriate. All lengths refer to the overall length, which will be determined by the Parkers Car Price Guide (January edition of the championship year) for the car concerned or, if not quoted, by the manufacturer's specification. A list of approved Sports Kit Cars eligible for class C and E is held by the Secretary and any additions to this list will be at the discretion of the BTRDA® Autotest Committee. The Championship organisers reserve the right to reclassify vehicles in Class E.

[9] VEHICLES STARTING POSITIONS AND TIMING

Whenever possible cars should run in number order within their class.

Competitors will start in their own time after clearance from the timekeeper. The timing line will be approximately 1m in front of the start line.

[10] PRACTICE REQUIREMENTS

Practicing will not be allowed anywhere on the site.

[11] IDENTIFICATION

Numbers will be provided by the organisers.

[12] JUDGES OF FACT

All marshals will be appointed as judges of fact to adjudicate on penalties NCR 19 App 9.

[13] AWARDS

AWARDS WILL BE PRESENTED AS FOLLOWS: -

Fastest Time of Day.

1st in each class.

2nd in each class subject to a minimum of 5 starters.

1st Novice (defined as a person who has not previously won a class of more than 3 competitors on an autotest at Clubman or higher status) subject to a minimum of 3 Novices.

1st Loughborough Car Club member - The Sutherland plate and replica.

No competitor may win more than one award, other than 1st Novice and 1st Loughborough

All awards are perpetual except for the Sutherland plate.

[14] ENTRIES

The maximum entry for the event is 40 and the minimum is 15. Should any of the above minimum figures not be reached, the organisers have the right to amalgamate classes or cancel the event.

A car may be entered to compete twice but no driver may drive more than one vehicle.

(Ch3 App5 Art7)

Vehicles do not need to be currently registered and taxed unless entered in Class E

(CH.19 App3 Art.1.2)
