ELIGIBILITY

To score points the championship competitors must be championship members of Loughborough Car Club and have paid the £5.00 registration fee-

Note:- To enter the events drivers, and passengers, must be full members of an invited club and registering for either championship does not constitute membership of an invited club.

AWARDS.

These will be awarded at the end of the series of events and are awarded separately for the AutoSolo championship & Junior AutoSolo championship.

AutoSolo Championship

First Overall

1st in Class

2nd in Class subject to 5 drivers scoring points

3rd in Class subject to 8 drivers scoring points

Junior Awards

Note to qualify for awards the driver must be under 18 at the first round.

First Overall

Second Overall

Third Overall

Note:- Points can only be scored by drivers. There are no passenger awards.

Awards Evening.

There will be an awards evening in the four weeks following the series results being declared final.

POINTS

There are four rounds to the championship. If a competitor competes in all four rounds, then their best three scores will count towards their series total.

Points will be awarded in the Championship with reference to class position in the official results. There will also be extra points based upon class size.

Class position	1st	2nd	3rd	4th	5th	6th	7th	8th	9th	etc
Points	25	24	23	22	21	20	19	18	17	etc

In addition, 1 point will be scored for each registered starter beaten in the class up to a maximum of 3 points and one point deducted for each competitor who beats you. There will be no negative points.

i.e. If you finish 1st in a class of six you would have 3 extra points (maximum 3 points) less 0 points as no-one beat you in your class, Totalling 3 points.

If you should finish 2nd in a class of six you would have 3 points less the one that beat you, Totalling 2 points.

But if you were second in a class of three, you would have 1 point less the one that beat you, Totalling 0 points.

For the overall results points may be scored in different classes.

Junior Driver:- To qualify for the Junior awards the driver must be under 18 on 8th November 2025.

SERIES TIE DECIDER:

Clause A. In the event of a tie for position after the four rounds of the series, the highest points score on the first round will take precedence. If this does not resolve the tie, the highest points on the second round will be referred to and so on.

Clause B. If a tie still exists, reference will then be made to the highest combined overall finishing positions on the three scoring rounds of the series.

Clause C. If a tie still exists, the highest overall position in the first round will take precedence.

No competitor may win more than one award except for Junor awards.
