Conduct: When you're not on the test, please drive slowly. Pedestrians may be distracted, and we want to maintain good relations with Donington.

Signing On: Will be in the Launch Pad building just next to our paddock. <u>Licences & Club Cards must be presented at signing on.</u>

Scrutineering: There is no scrutineering before the event, random checks for safety and eligibility will happen whilst the event is under way.

The Test: There is one test site. You will get four attempts at each test layout, best 3 to count. We plan to run two different layouts. To facilitate this please report for driving and marshalling duties promptly.

Walking the Tests: It is strongly recommended that you walk the tests to familiarise yourself with the route. There will be time to walk each layout in turn. Please arrive in good time so you can walk the first layout.

Marshalling: You will be required to assist with marshalling duties. Please report to the Marshalling Coordinator, located next to the start line, immediately upon completing each driving session. Compliance will be monitored by the Marshalling Coordinator. Your marshalling duty will normally take place directly after your driving session. Juniors may undertake marshalling in the presence of a parent or other responsible adult; however, the duty must still be fulfilled. Marshalling outside the allocated time must be arranged in advance with the Coordinator.

Numbers: These will be supplied and should be affixed to the side of the car. You will be given these at Signing On. Note the colour of these numbers matches the group you belong to (see below).

Catering & Toilets: Toilet facilities are located in the Launch Pad Building. Facilities for making tea and coffee are available near the start/finish area. If possible, please bring your own mug.

Garage 39 Café will be open; however, we request that you bring your own lunch as a track day is taking place and queues are likely to be long. Please note that event timings will be strictly adhered to, and sessions will continue as scheduled even if you arrive late for your allocated slot.

Trailers: Competitors bringing a trailer will participate in the PCA and not score championship points.

Results Service: All timing & results are on the "TimingAppLive phone app.
